

# The 6<sup>th</sup> Annual Beaverton Celebration 5K Parade Run

The Beaverton Parade Run (BPR) is a 5K, timed run winding along the same city streets and just prior to the start of the Beaverton Celebration Parade for runners and walkers of all ages and abilities. Become involved—as a participant, a spectator, or simply a supporter with a donation.

A Youth Dash for the little ones 10-and-under, kicks off the morning. It precedes the 5K start, which is open to runners and walkers. Strollers are allowed as part of the walkers, but unfortunately due to insurance concerns, *no dogs or pets are allowed*. Additional details and information can be found at:

8:30am Day-of registration closes at 8:30am so that we can start on time  
8:45am The Youth Dash for age 10 and under begins  
9:00am National Anthem, final instructions, sponsor recognition, and then the START!

Pre-registration (online before Sept. 8) is \$20 for all 5K adult runners and walkers and \$15 for juniors 17 and under

Youth-dash is free but requires a number and parental waiver to participate (available online or at registration)

**Course:** Leaves from Griffith Park and heads back along the parade route to the Parade start. Then runners and walkers will loop through Schiffler Park before returning back to the finish in Griffith Park. The entire route is closed to vehicle traffic with parade spectators setting up along the entire Parade Run and Celebration Parade route. A PDF map is available on our website.

**Directions:** Our Parade Run begins and ends at Griffith Park in Beaverton. Free parking around the park is available. Enter from the Beaverton-Hillsdale Hwy side.

**Categories:** The free children's Youth Dash is open to youth 10 and under. The 5K categories are Junior: Youth 17 and under; Senior: Adults 18 - 39; and Masters: Adults 40 and over. Prizes awarded to top male and female finishers, and then the top 3 category finishers.
